Women's Community Support Center, located in Hancock County, MS, is a collaborative effort between **Gulf Coast Christian Women's Job Corps (GCCWJC)** and **Magdalene House** residential community. We are designed to serve as a safe haven for women in our community whose lives have been shattered by the interwoven issues of homelessness, incarceration and drug or alcohol dependency.

**Gulf Coast Christian Women's Job Corps** offers help and hope for women in our community by providing computer classes, job training, money management, bible study and more.

**Magdalene House** offers residents a therapeutic setting, which offers women a peaceful place where they can experience transformative, sustainable recovery through housing, counseling, and community building.

## **Our Founding**

Founded by **Diane Bennett** and **Barbara Ambrose** in 2019, GCCWJC/Magdalene House is a faith based 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization located in Hancock County Mississippi. We seek to empower women and minister to their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs, enabling them to move from addiction, homelessness, and/or incarceration to a stable and independent life.

## **Our Mission**

Our mission is to encourage women to pursue a relationship with Jesus Christ, to provide hope, and to move them toward self-sufficiency by providing education, mentoring, and strength-based skills.

#### **Our Vision**

# **Workforce Reentry Programs**

Gulf Coast Christian Women's Job Corps, Goodwill Industries, Hancock Family Intervention in partnership with Hancock County Detention Center and Mississippi Department of Corrections (MDOC) is providing workforce, reentry programs to the female inmates at the Hancock County jail. This program offers tools, skills and knowledge to assist these women with successful reentry back into the community. They obtain skills on resume building, job search in the communities in which they will return and work place soft skills. Thank you to all of the agencies that are collaborating to change lives, generations to come and our communities.

The women that will live in the Gulf Coast area are referred to our work force reentry program in Bay St. Louis to further their opportunities and find sustainable employment. **Magdalene House** is an option for some of the women if they need safe sober living upon release.




